As the ECE-A, you will be responsible for supporting (*ECE/Manager*) in: planning and carrying out culturally safe and developmentally appropriate activities that honour the customs and traditions of the Nooaitch community.

PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Follows the general day to day activities or operations of the AHSOR program
- 2. Promotes, encourages and assures the AHSOR 6 components are implemented and delivered for children and their families
- 3. Assists in the implementation of culturally responsive and developmentally appropriate early education activities/curriculum in all programs, while embedding the teachings of the Nooaitch Community
- 4. Follows general program services and or deliveries as directed while ensuring procedures, policies etc. are maintained and updated.
- 5. Submit accurate and timely reports as directed
- 6. Performs other related duties as assigned.

- 1. Knowledge of AHSOR 6 components, practices and principles related to early child learning/development
- 2. Knowledge of needs specific to Aboriginal/First Nations populations in the area of early child learning and development
- 3. Encourages families to participate in a variety of meaningful opportunities as they are available. Demonstrates the ability to build trust and positive relationships with families in the program
- 4. Act as a role model of appropriate behavior
- 5. Ability to work cooperatively as a member of the childcare team, environment through personal behavior, work contributions and the sharing of knowledge
- 6. Participates in the developing of new ideas and methods for program enhancement and has the ability to adjust and adapt to changes
- 7. Takes personal initiative with good planning and organizational skills
